- After 15 months of war on seven frontlines, fighting for the right to exist—both as Israel and as Jews—we now experience a fragile hope for some ease and rest, as there is currently a "truce" at the northern and southern borders.
- The last two years have been terrible, and the healing of the deep wound left by October 7 will take time. Anything truly valuable does.
- We thank the Lord for His protection and for the enormous privilege—though costly—of living in Israel at this historic time and serving Him by sharing who He is, His perfect plan, and pointing people back to the only true source of strength, hope, and salvation.
- We do this through four areas of ministry:
 - 1. Translating Dr. Fruchtenbaum's teachings
 - 2. Biblical Counseling for Messianic Believers
 - The war has deeply scarred many souls, affecting marriages, families, and personal struggles.
 - We meet with up to three couples a day (each session lasting two hours).
 - We also work with individuals experiencing trauma and PTSD symptoms.
 - We launched a 10-episode podcast featuring pastors, leaders, and mature believers, discussing pressing spiritual and psychological topics during this time of war.
 - We have been invited to speak at conferences on "How to Overcome Psychological and Spiritual Difficulties During War."
 - 3. Messianic Congregational Ministry
 - Sasha serves as one of two elders.
 - Visiting and praying with people in need.
 - Participating in a discipleship program for the next generation of potential leaders.
 - 4. Serving Adults with Special Needs (Makom Ba Lev)

- Makom Ba Lev: We envision a place where uniquely gifted individuals can live with dignity, engage in meaningful activities, and build social connections, always surrounded by caregivers who truly care. Please pray with us as we seek God's provision for this vision.
